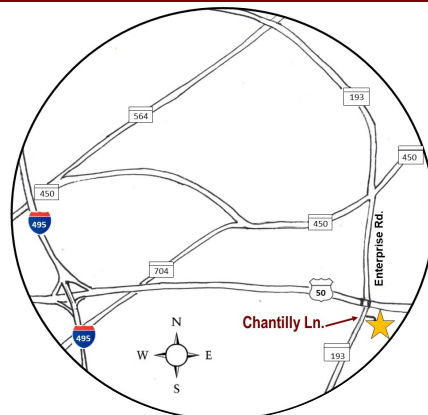

Our Philosophy of Education

Our Program

- We offer small, multi-grade classrooms from Jr. kindergarten through twelfth grade.

- We offer a full curriculum which includes religious studies, visual and performance arts, STEM, languages, music and physical education.



- Our church inspired curriculum integrates national standards with spiritual beliefs.

- Often our students test one grade level or more above the national Average.

Tuition Information

Tuition for the 2021-2022 school year is \$7,875*. There is a materials fee surcharge for Grades 7-8 of \$300/per child. Families also pay a \$400 *refundable* deposit for the Parent Service Program (PSP). We encourage parents to contribute by sharing their skills and talents at work parties, mentoring, chaperoning for trips, hosting events and many other activities of building the school community. All these earn them PSP hours.

- There is a non-refundable \$100 fee for new applications.
- A 9-month payment contract is available.

When you apply you will be provided with a WNC School Handbook. Once enrolled you will receive the school's weekly *E-news*, *The ECHO* (our monthly church newsletter) and a calendar of events.

New parents are asked to attend introductory classes and/or some Sunday morning church services (11am) to gain understanding of our unique Christian perspective. While we do not require church attendance of anyone, we do ask that you attend a least a few services with us to hear the teachings applied to life and to get to know other parents and members in this community. (Sundays @ 11:00 AM)
