



**WNCS SCHOOL SUPPLY LISTS  
2021-2022**

*The following lists of supplies are to be purchased by the parents or students and are to be brought with them on the first day of school. Many of the following supplies run out or wear out during the course of a year. The school does not provide these supplies for student use. See that your child is resupplied when necessary.*

**JR. K & Kindergarten: (Please label everything - every pencil/crayon/marker - with your child's name)**

A backpack or other school bag (*at least 10" X 18"*)

(6) Glue Sticks

1 small bottle of Elmer's glue **1.25 oz size** - no bigger

(1) Pair of scissors (prefer Fiskars kids sharp point)

Small water bottle – no-spill, **flip-up top** (not necessary to unscrew to drink) no taller than 8"

(2) Boxes of facial tissues

(1) Blanket (for "books and blankets" time) throw size – labeled with name

*If you can, please send a pair of rubber boots to keep at school for outside play/walks. I do have some extras if this is not possible.*

**NOTE:** *A bag with your child's name on the outside filled with a complete change of clothes (including socks and underwear... does not need to be uniform) AND A PACK OF FLUSHABLE WIPES –for personal emergencies.*

**1<sup>st</sup> & 2nd GRADES: (Please label everything - every pencil/crayon - with your child's name)**

(1) Box (doz.) #2 pencils (*made of WOOD not composite*) Sharpened

(1) Box 16 or more crayons

(1) Block eraser – pink\*

(1) pkg. pink eraser caps\*

(1) (Small) supply box

(1) Pair of scissors

(1) Bottle Elmer's washable/school glue

(5) Pocket folders (**with fasteners**) – different colors

(1) Box colored pencils

(1) Reusable Water bottle

*Optional: If your child has a blanket, they want to keep at school for reading time, they can bring it in.*

**No Markers, Please!**

**3<sup>rd</sup> & 4th GRADES: (Please label everything in the top 14 items on this list - every pencil/crayon/marker - with your child's name or initials)**

(1) Box (doz.) #2 Pencils (*Wood not composite*), no mechanical pencils. Please label each pencil with your child's name or initials. Put the name near the eraser end of the pencil. A sharpie works fine for this.

(1) Block eraser (pink), labeled with student's name or initials

(1) Pkg. erasers for pencil tips (pink), label each eraser

(2) Pkgs. of washable markers, one fat and one thin pack, label each marker

(1) Box of colored pencils, label each pencil

- (1) 24 count box crayons (*optional*), labeled
- (1) Pencil box, large enough to hold all pencils, colored pencils, markers, erasers, and scissors.
- (1) Handheld pencil sharpener, preferably good quality metal
- (1) Glue stick
- (3) Pocket folders (with fasteners)
- (3) Marbled composition books – **wide** ruled
- (1) 3 ring binder with pocket in front (2 inch or 2 ½ inch, no bigger please)
- (1) Pair of scissors--with pointed tips. Please label everything on this list from the first item down to the scissors with your child's name or initials.
- (1) Pkg. (100 sheets) **wide** ruled notebook paper
- (1) Large box of facial tissue
- (1) Package dividers, 5 subjects
- (4) Black only – whiteboard markers

**5th & 6th GRADES: Please label all student's supplies**

- (1) Pkg. (or packages) (300 sheets min.) College ruled notebook paper (more will be needed later in the year.)
- (1) Box (doz.) #2 Pencils (Wood not composite) **or** mechanical pencils with ample refills (label each pencil with student's name)
- (6) Ball point pens (blue or black) (label each pen with student's name)
- (3) Ball point pen (red) (label each pen with student's name)
- (1) hand-held pencil sharpener
- (1) Pkg. colored pencils (label each pencil with student's name)
- (3) Pocket folders (with fasteners) prefer plastic for durability
- (1) 2 or 2 ½ inch binder (no bigger than this)
- (1) Plastic pocket folder with fasteners to be used for homework assignments
- (2) Pkgs. of dividers or more (10 subjects)
- (1) Big box of Kleenex
- (1) Pair of scissors labeled with student's name
- (1) ea. - Metric ruler, protractor & compass labeled with student's name
- (1) pkg. Colored markers (label each marker with student's name)
- (1) pkg. eraser caps (pink)\*
- (1) Composition book (writing journal)
- (1) Bottle of "White Out" (optional)
- (1) Block Eraser\* labeled with student's name
- (1) Glue stick
- (1) Black sharpie

(For TT/WP for Mrs. Kunkle) (1) USB/Flash drive with lanyard (***labeled with student's name***)
