

The following lists of supplies are to be purchased by the parents or students and are to be brought with them on the first day of school. Many of the following supplies run out or wear out during the course of a year. The school does not provide these supplies for student use. See that your child is resupplied when necessary.

JR. K & Kindergarten: (Please label everything - every pencil/crayon/marker - with your child's name)

A backpack or other school bag (no smaller than 13" X 16")

- (6) Glue Sticks
- (1) Pair of scissors (prefer Fiskars kids' sharp point)

Water bottle – no-spill, **flip-up top** (not necessary to unscrew to drink) **no taller than 8"**. This will be kept in the fridge in the classroom.

- (2) Boxes of facial tissues
- (1) Blanket (for "books and blankets" time) throw size, no bigger than 4' X 6' labeled with name

NOTE: A disposable bag with your child's name on the outside filled with a complete change of clothes (including socks and underwear - not shoes... does not need to be uniform) AND A PACK OF FLUSHABLE WIPES -for personal emergencies.

If you can, please send a pair of rubber boots to keep at school for outside play/walks. I do have some extras if this is not possible.

1st & 2nd GRADES: (Please label everything - every pencil/crayon - with your child's name)

- (1) Box (doz.) #2 pencils (made of **WOOD** not composite) Sharpened
- (1) Box 16 or more crayons
- (1) Block eraser pink
- (1) pkg. pink eraser caps * If you cannot find the "Pink" block erasers or caps you can buy from the office
- (1) (Small) supply box
- (1) Pair of scissors
- (1) Bottle Elmer's washable/school glue
- (5) Pocket folders (with fasteners) different colors
- (1) Box colored pencils
- (1) Reusable Water bottle

Optional: If your child has a blanket, they want to keep at school for reading time, they can bring it in. No Markers, Please!

3rd & 4th GRADES: (Please label every pencil/crayon/marker - with your child's

- 1) Block eraser (pink), labeled with student's name or initials
- (2) Pkgs. of washable markers, one fat and one thin pack, label each marker
- (1) Box of colored pencils, label each pencil
- (1) 24 count box crayons (optional), labeled
- (1) Pencil box, not large, just big enough to hold pencils, colored pencils, and markers
- (1) Handheld pencil sharpener, preferably good quality metal
- (1) 3 ring binder with pocket in front (2 inch or 2 ½ inch, no bigger please)
- (1) Pair of scissors--with pointed tips.
- (1) Large box of facial tissue
- (1) Reusable water bottle

5th & 6th GRADES: Please label all student's supplies

- (1) Pkg. (or packages) (200 sheets min.) College ruled notebook paper (more may be needed later.)
- (1) Box (doz.) #2 or HB Pencils (Wood not composite) **OR** 9mm mechanical pencils w/ refills, labeled.
- (3) Ball point pens (blue or black) (label each pen with student's name)
- (3) Red Ball point pens (labeled)
- (1) hand-held pencil sharpener, with a shavings container preferably.
- (1) 2" or 2½ inch three-ring binder (no bigger than this)
- (1) Plastic pocket folder with fasteners to be used for homework assignments
- (2) Pkgs. of dividers or more (8 subjects)
- (1) Glue stick
- (1) Black sharpie
- (1) Big box of Kleenex
- (1) Block Eraser* labeled with student's name
- (1) Pair of scissors labeled with student's name
- (1) pkg. of Dry-Erase markers, Black (label each marker with student's name)
- (1) Reusable water bottle, labeled with student's name, for use throughout the year. (no plastic disposable bottles).

(For TT/WP for Miss Kinsey) (1) USB/Flash drive with lanyard (labeled with student's name) Optional:

- *(1) Pkg. colored markers (label each marker with student's name) (OPTIONAL)
- *(1) Pkg. colored pencils (label each pencil with student's name) (OPTIONAL)
- *(1) Bottle of "White Out" (OPTIONAL)
