


## **Philosophy**

#### **Tuition**

**Tuition for the 2024-2025 school year is \$9,300\*.** There is a materials fee surcharge for Grades 7<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>h</sup> of \$320/per child. Families also pay a \$400 *refundable* deposit for the Parent Service Program (PSP). We encourage parents to contribute by sharing their skills and talents.

Discounts available for multiple children and for payment of at least 20% of tuition by Aug 10th deadline.

- There is a non-refundable \$300 fee for new applications. (\$200 discount for applications before May 31).
- A 9-month payment plan is available.

#### **Communication**

When you apply you will be provided with a WNC School Handbook. Once enrolled you will receive the school's weekly *E-news, The ECHO* (our monthly church newsletter) and a calendar of events.

New parents are invited to attend Sunday morning church services (11am) to gain understanding of our unique Christian perspective. While we do not require church attendance of anyone, participation allows you to hear the teachings applied to life and to get to know other parents and members in this community.

\*Please note: Our tuition is about half the full cost to educate a student. The balance being contributed by church members, alumni, and friends.
